Within 24 Hours <i>Late Payment Report</i>	8/6/25 – 11/4/25	498	<ul style="list-style-type: none">File if a payment of \$2,500 or more is received from a single source to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 4, 2025 election.File by personal delivery, e-mail, guaranteed overnight service, or fax. The committee may also file online if available.
Sep 25, 2025 <i>1st Pre-Election</i>	7/1/25 – 9/20/25	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none">File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 4, 2025 election.
Oct 23, 2025 <i>2nd Pre-Election</i>	9/21/25 – 10/18/25	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none">File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 4, 2025 election.
Feb 2, 2026** <i>Semi-Annual</i>	10/19/25 – 12/31/25	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.

Additional Notes:

- * Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- ** Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such a report must be filed within 24 hours, regardless of the day of the week.
- Method of Delivery:** Unless otherwise noted, all paper filings may be filed by mail. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing under a local ordinance.
- An SMO receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or payments that are from a third party to list a candidate or measure, should call the FPPC for advice.
