Additional Notes:

- *Deadline Extensions: Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour/10-day Contribution Report (Form 497) that is due the weekend before an election, and this extension never applies to any 24-hour/10-day Independent Expenditure Report (Form 496). Such reports must be filed within 24 hours, regardless of the day of the week.
- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- E-Filer: A state committee that has received contributions or made expenditures totaling \$25,000 or more.
- Where to File Form 460 with Secretary of State: E-filers file the original online and one paper copy with the Secretary of State. Committees that may not e-file, file the original in paper format with the Secretary of State.
- Where to File Form 460 with CalPERS: E-filers and non e-filers must also e-mail a copy to CalPERS at Board Election Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov.
- **Form 460:** Candidates who have raised/spent \$2,000 or more file the Form 460. The Form 410 (Statement of Organization) must also be filed once \$2,000 or more has been raised/spent.
- Form 470: Candidates who do not raise or spend \$2,000 or more (or anticipate raising or spending \$2,000 or more) in 2025 and do not have an open committee may file Form 470 on or before August 27, 2025. If the candidate raises or spends \$2,000 or more later during the calendar year, a campaign committee must be opened, and a Form 470 Supplement and a Form 410 must be filed.
- Forms 496 and 497: All reports filed online with the Secretary of State and e-mailed to CalPERS at <u>Board_Election_Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov</u>.
- Paper Filings with Secretary of State: All paper filings may be filed by first-class mail or by email with a verified digital signature unless otherwise noted.
 Persons required to file a report or statement by paper with the Secretary of State's Office may instead file by email (digitalfiling@sos.ca.gov) with a verified digital signature or other digital means as prescribed by the Secretary of State's Office. Please visit the Secretary of State's website for more information on how to file with a digital signature.
- **Multiple Candidate Controlled Committees:** All committees controlled by a CalPERS candidate must file statements on each filing deadline, in addition to the committee formed for this election.
- **Penalties:** Late statements are subject to a fine of \$10 per day on both the paper and the e-filed version (i.e., \$20 per day for a late e-filed Form 460). Failure to file a statement or report could result in an enforcement penalty of \$5,000 per violation.
- Contribution Limits: Contributions to CalPERS candidates are subject to contribution limits of \$5,900 per election from individuals, businesses, committees/PACs; and \$11,800 from small contributor committees. Committees that make contributions to CalPERS candidates may only accept contributions of up to \$9,800 from a single source in a calendar year. Refer to the contribution limits chart of the FPPC website for further information.
- Public Documents: All statements and reports are public documents.

- Voting Periods: Begins August 29, 2025 for the September 29, 2025 election and November 7, 2025 for the December 8, 2025 runoff election.
