Within 24 Hours Late Payment Report	3/4/26 - 6/2/26	<u>498</u>	 File if a payment of \$2,500 or more is received from a single source to produce a slate mailer in connection with the June 2, 2026, election. File by personal delivery, e-mail, guaranteed overnight service, or fax. The committee may also file online if available.
Apr 23, 2026 1st Pre-Election	1/1/26 – 4/18/26	<u>401</u>	• File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the June 2, 2026, election.
May 21, 2026 2 nd Pre-Election	4/19/26 - 5/16/26	401	• File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the June 2, 2026, election.
Jul 31, 2026 Semi-Annual	* - 6/30/26	<u>401</u>	All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.

Additional Notes:

- *Period Covered: The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours, regardless of the day of the week.
- **Method of Delivery:** Unless otherwise noted, all paper filings may be filed by first-class mail. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- A slate mailer organization (SMO) receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or receiving payments from a
 third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, should reference the <u>Slate Mailer Organization Manual</u> for information on reporting and disclosure
 requirements.
- Public Documents: All statements and reports are public documents.
